Morrison do hereby associate to form a non-stock, non-profit corporation under the Laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and more particularly KRS 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be Area Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The principal office and place of business of the corporation shall be

Area Volunteer Fire Department Headquarters, Wayland, Floyd County, Kentucky.

ARTICLE III.

The process agent shall be E. H. Morrison, Wayland, Kentucky. The post office shall be Wayland, Floyd County, Kentucky.

ARTICLE IV.

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V.

The nature of the business, and the purpose of said corporation shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- (A) The development and maintenance of adequate fire fighting facilities in the Area of Wayland, and
- (B) The development and maintenance of adequate personnel to carry on fire fighting and objectives, and
- (C) The training and education of personnel to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of volunteer firemen in said area.
- (D) And to perform any act whatsoever not inconsistent with the

 Laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and to carry out the

 purpose of said corporation.

ARTICLE VI.

The incorporators herein shall constitute the initial Board of Directors and they shall serve until new directors are elected by the corporate members pursuant to the by-laws to be adopted by said corporation.
