


TO YOU, GOVERNOR COMBS,

FILOYDIAN

Bert T. Combs, born and reared in the mountains of Eastern Kentucky, became the 54th Governor of the Commonwealth on December 8, 1959. He was only 15 when he graduated from Clay County High School and ranked No. 1 scholastically in his class. He attended Cumberland College at Williamsburg, Kentucky, from 1929 to 1931, firing furnaces and sweeping out buildings to earn his college education. Combs went to work as a clerk in the state highway department. Three years later he entered the University of Kentucky law school. There he became managing Editor of the Kentucky Law Journal, a prized honor. When he received his law degree in 1937, he was second in his class and received the medal of the Order of Coif, highest honor for law graduates. He also recieved honorary doctorates (law) from Findlay College, Findlay, Ohio, 1960 and University of Kentucky, Lexington, Kentucky, 1961. Combs practiced law in his home town of Manchester, then moved his law practice to Prestonsburg, Floyd County, which remains his home. In 1942, he enlisted as an army private in World War II. He was awarded the Bronze Star and the Medal of Merit (Philippine Islands). Combs resumed the practice of law in Prestonsburg and served as City Attorney in 1950-51. When a judgeship on the Court of Appeals became vacant in 1951, all the judges recommended Combs' appointment to Kentucky's highest court. He was married in 1937 to Miss Mabel Hall of Knott County and Lexington and they have two children: Lois Ann and Thomas George. The soft-spoken New Governor, elevated at the age of 48 to chief executive of the state government in which he once worked as a \$125-a-month highway department clerk. acted with confidence bulwarked by the record-breaking endorsement given him in the November 3, 1959 election. Defining his goal of progress for Kentucky, Combs said: "I mean the advancement of those programs which will stimulate the economy of our state and improve the living conditions of our people. Specifically, I mean such programs as educational advancement, development of research and the building of more and better highways."

Never tiring, never relenting regardless of criticism, you have faithfully labored four short but fruitful years for the people of Kentucky. And Governor Combs, we regard you, not only as a very dedicated public servant but as a wonderful friend. With many thanks for your interest in the school children of Kentucky, we the staff of the 1963 Floyd Countian wish to dedicate to you this record of a year's events in Floyd County.










WE GROW

He has brought victory 351 times to our school. Many of the 168 defeats have been considered the most exciting games in basketball history. Mr. Halbert is loved and respected not only as a great coach but also a very proficient instructor.
